Healthy Schools News: Coughing

The average sneeze or **cough** can send around 100,000 contagious **germs** into the air at speeds up to 100 miles per hour. These **germs** can carry viruses, such as influenza, respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) and adenoviruses, which cause the common cold.

These tips can help stop the spread of germs:

1. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
2. Put your used tissue in a waste basket.
3. If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your **upper sleeve** or **inside your shirt**, not your hands.

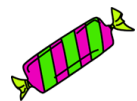
