

DRESS CODE

All students in Polk County have a standard uniform of dress which must be worn daily. Students must have their shirts tucked in and pants are worn at the waist. For Dr. N.E. Roberts' Elementary students, collared shirts must be navy, white, burgundy or hunter green. The only collarless shirts allowed are Dr. Roberts' tee shirts, which are sold by the school. Bottoms may be khaki (tan), black, or navy in twill, corduroy, or denim (jeans). No overalls are permitted and all pants must be free of decorations. Children must wear a belt if their pants/shorts have belt loops. All shoes must be CLOSED and have regular heels on them. (No sandals, flip flops, or wheels) As per the Code of Conduct, students are not allowed to wear clothing, jewelry, buttons, haircuts, hair styles, tattoos, or other attire or markings which are offensive, suggestive, disruptive, or indecent.
